August 22, 2017

1) Cure CYO Board Business: Kyle Schudy

- a) In general, need to be diligent about meeting minutes and record keeping. Particularly beneficial if there are several member changes.
- b) Board positions
 - i) Assistant AD/DMS: Aaron Hass to take over in 2018-2019 season
 - ii) Basketball Coordinator: Kirk Eskew to continue this season. Brian Maher will shadow this season and take over coordinator position in 2018-2019 season. Board approved by unanimous vote.
 - iii) Cross Country: Bethann Baker & Jill Clements as co-coordinators. Board approved by unanimous vote.
 - iv) Football: Jeff Grantham to continue
 - v) Track: Marcelle Bruck does not want to continue. Discussed having two track coordinators – separate ones for boys and girls.
 - vi) Treasurer: Kathleen Wynne to continue
 - vii) Uniform Coordinator: Samantha Colburn to continue
 - viii) Volleyball: Kelli Martin to continue this season. Will start to look for someone to replace her; possibly shadow next season, and replace in 2019
 - ix) Kyle to continue handling High School Basketball & Gym Management; Ray still on as gym manager

2) JOCO/WYCO CYO Update: Kyle Schudy and Aaron Hass

- a) Online registration updates: Kyle Schudy continuing to send roster updates.
- b) Pete Piscitiello resigned as Executive Director. Position open; Shaw Leach is acting Director.
- c) Pooling equipment/uniform orders to as to help smaller parishes with cost. Pooling orders will create volume discounts, even if only ordering in small amounts, i.e. a few uniform jerseys, t-shirts, etc. Jeff to look into new vendors.
- d) Have volunteer doctor(s) provide physicals one day during end of spring/summer, before school is out. Pay small fee (\$15) for about 15 minute visit. Bishop Meige does this for their students. Will also help for students to commit to playing fall sports. Kyle to talk to some doctors who are parishioners.

- 3) Financial Update: Kathleen Wynne
 - a) Account officially moved to Bank of Louisburg. Online bill pay not available, but not being charged for writing checks. Aaron, Kyle, Kathleen, and Fr. Storey all signatories on account.
 - b) CYO funds separate from parish funds, but Fr. Storey would like to be apprised of financial standings

- 4) Individual Sport Updates and Equipment/Spending Needs: Individual Coordinators
 - a) Basketball: Kathleen to help with evaluations as done by Cindy in past
 - b) Cross Country

 - d) Track & Field: Get t-shirts for students to keep as with Cross Country. Jeff to look into vendor options.
 - c) Volleyball: Consideration of travel balls to help smaller parishes' equipment needs

- 5) New Track/XC/Gym Records Board: Kyle Schudy
 - a) Unable to track down Cure CYO records – Kyle will discuss CYO
 - b) Kyle met with new gym teacher, Jackie Buser.
 - (1) Will have new records boards this year
 - (2) Current records are from ten school-related events (grades 3 – 8)
 - (3) Keep/update and add new CYO board (honoring Jennifer Waldenmeyer)

- 6) Social for CYO coaches and volunteers: Keep on as an annual event. Although it was not heavily attended, it is good to show appreciation, particularly for volunteers without children.

- 7) New Principal and CYO promotion: Kyle Schudy
 - a) New Principal, Andrew Legler, very enthused about CYO, as is Fr. Storey. He will strongly support it.
 - b) Kyle to make presentation at back to school nights for parental involvement and kids participation.

- 8) Info on new Parish Master Plan: Kyle Schudy
 - a) New gym would be several years down the road, so it will be beneficial to redo gym floor.
 - b) Gym Floor: This holiday break it will be refinished (approx. \$3k); summer 2018 sanded, refinished, repainted (approx.. \$16k). Volleyball lines will be changed.
 - c) New logo: Good time for one when gym floor is repainted. Jeff to do some research of available college logos.
